Date of Invitation:	February 8, 2004
Closing Date	February 24, 2004. Additional charge of \$25 will apply to all entries received after this date.
Late Entries	For Dressage and SEA Showjumping Open Championships, entries must reach the Organizer by Tuesday, 24 th February 2004. Other showjumping entries will be accepted up to two (2) hours before the commencement of the class.
Entry Cancellation	Entries officially withdrawn no later than 24 hours before the start of competition must be verified by the original Doctor's or Vet's certificate (submitted to the Event Secretary by March 7 th 2004) for a 50% refund on the entry fee.
Entry Forms	All entries must be made using the prescribed forms attached.
Payment of Entries	To accompany Entry Forms. All payments by cheque shall be made payable to Bukit Timah Saddle Club . Entries may be made in person, by post, fax or on-line and will be confirmed when the Waiver Form and FULL payment is received.

COMPETITION RULES & REGULATIONS

Rules of Competition

The competition will run under the EFS and FEI rules. In any circumstances where the EFS rules are not available the Organizing Committee will have the authority to make decision. This competition is sanctioned by The Equestrian Federation of Singapore. All the participating riders must be registered with the EFS to be able to participate.

In-House Rules

- All riders are expected to wear a hard hat, riding boots and shirt when on the horse.
- The competition grounds and stable area must be kept clean and tidy at all times.
- Washing down horses should be done in the washing bays only and not inside the stables.
- Cooking inside the stable modules will not be allowed.
- You are provided with plastic bags for the disposal of dung and other refuse. The dung/waste must be removed from the sawdust daily and disposed of in a proper manner.
- At the end of the competition, all stables must be cleaned of all dung and waste.

The organizer reserves the right to

- Bill any participating club the cost of cleaning stables.
- Alter advertised times if necessary.
- Cancel any event or class.
- Divide any class.
- Refuse any class.

Stabling

Stabling is charged at **\$20.00 per day**. Stable request form is attached.

Horse Passport

Passports must be available upon entry into the competition venue.

Vaccination Certificate

The horses competing have to be inoculated against Equine Influenza and Japanese B Virus. The medical records must indicate proper inoculations and clearance. If these conditions are not complied with; the horses will be denied access to the competition.

Horse Arrival/Departure

The horses will be allowed in the stables from **25th February 2004 till the 1st March 2004**.

Horse Numbers

Horse Identification Numbers will be distributed at the Technical Briefing for riders or can be collected at the secretariat.

Technical Briefing

A technical briefing will be held at the BTSC club house on the **27th February 2004 at 6:30 PM**.

Insurance

All owners and competitors are personally responsible for damages to third persons caused by themselves, their employees, their agents and their horses. They are therefore strongly advised to take out third party insurance providing full coverage for participation in Equestrian events at home and abroad, and to keep their policy up to date.

Dress Code Dressage	White, off-white or beige jodhpurs or breeches, jacket, riding helmet, long black riding boots and gloves. Jackets are optional in Walk-Trot, Preliminary and Novice. Riders in Medium competitions may wear a top hat provided they are using a double bridle.
Dress Code Showjumping	Jackets are compulsory for all sponsored classes and/or classes above 100cm.
Junior Rider	Riders under 16 years of age
Young Rider	Riders 16-21 years old
Young Horse	Horses under 6 year old
Green Horse	Horse in it's first year of training / re-training / showing.

HORSE PASSPORTS/VACCINATIONS

Please be informed that all horses and ponies intending to participate in this Competition should possess the 'Health Certificate' that certified free from Nipah Virus and required to be immunized against the following:-

- A) Equine Influenza (EI)
- B) Japanese B Encephalitis (Jap B)

Horses that have already been immunized must show documentary proof that the vaccinations have been performed by the **Official Veterinary Surgeon** or **Government Veterinary Surgeon**. These records must be entered in the horse registration cards. i.e. Horses and ponies attempting to enter **WITHOUT** up-to-date vaccination records will be denied entry to the club.

DRESSAGE RULES & REGULATIONS

Class 1 (Advanced)	Open to all riders and horses.
Class 2 (Medium)	Open to all riders and horses.
Class 3 (Elementary)	Open to all riders and horses. Whip is allowed.
Class 4 (Novice)	Open to all riders and horses, except horses competing in the Medium and Advanced. Same horse is allowed to start twice with a different rider. Whip is allowed.
Class 5a (Preliminary Open)	Open to all riders and horses, except horses competing in the Elementary, Medium and Advanced. Same horse is allowed to start twice with a different rider. Whip is allowed.
Class 5b (Preliminary Junior Rider)	Open to Young riders and all horses, except horses competing in the Medium and Advanced. Same horse is allowed to start twice with a different rider. Whip is allowed.
Class 5c (Young/Green Horse)	Open to all horses in their first year of training/re-training/showing only, may be ridden by any rider. Whip is allowed.
Class 6 (Walk-Trot)	Open to riders that have not been placed in Novice or better than 4 th place in Preliminary. Whip is allowed.
Class 12; 13; 14; 15 (Qualifier # 1)	According to the FEI/PSI World Cup Dressage Challenge Rules and Regulations.

JUMPING CLASSES RULES & REGULATIONS

Classes 7 (Clear Round)	Open to all riders and horses.
Classes 8; (Power & Speed)	Open to all riders and horses. <u>Art. 274.5.3.</u> A Competition over two phases without interruption. The 1 st phase will consist of 8-9 obstacles, judged under Table A, against the clock, with the time allowed. Riders who clear over Phase 1 will proceed immediately to Phase 2 (4-6 obstacles), judged also under Table A, against the clock. Places are classified according to the lowest Phase 2 faults and the fastest time. If no rider qualifies for Phase 2, the lowest faults and time in Phase 1 would be considered.
Classes 10;11 (SEA SJ Championships)	Open to all riders and horses. A horse may not be ridden by more than 1 rider in the same category. Refer to the SEA Showjumping Open Championships Rules and Regulations.
Classes 16; 17; 18 (AM 5)	Open to all riders and horses. <u>Art. 238.2.2.</u> A Competition against the clock,, but in the event of equality of faults for the first place, there will be a jump-off against the clock. Other competitors share equal placing according to their faults.

SEA SHOWJUMPING OPEN CHAMPIONSHIPS

GENERAL RULES

- There are 3 categories A, B, and C of different standards (125/115/105cm).
- Each category consists of **2 competitions** over different courses designed by a Course Designer designated by the SEA Showjumping Open Championship Competition Committee
- Each of the 2 competitions consists of 2 rounds under Table A. In case of equality of penalties after two rounds, the time of the second round will decide. The 2 competitions of 2 rounds must be run over a maximum of 3 days. The 2 rounds of a same competition must be jumped on the same day.
- The complete competition consists of 4 rounds. The final score for each competitor is the total penalties of the 4 rounds and the total of his time in the 2 second rounds. If the total of times is equal, the fastest time in the second round of the last competition will decide.
- The competition must be organized as outdoor events between the **25th February 2004 and the 7th April 2004**.

PARTICIPATION

- A country may organize any number of Categories, but **rider/horse combination** who compete in one Category is not allowed to compete in the others.
- A, B and C categories are open to all riders.
- The organizer may enter as many competitors as it wishes for each of the 3 categories.
- A rider domiciled in a foreign country may compete in the competition for the country in which he is domiciled.
- Competitors may ride more than one horse in the competition but the score of only one horse may count for points. This horse must be declared before the first competition begins and must be ridden as first horse in each first round. The results obtained with the other horses will not count towards the final standings.
- A horse may not be ridden by more than 1 rider in the same category.
- A competitor eliminated in one competition may start in the other competition. However, his/her results will not count towards the final classification.
- A draw for each competition will take place to decide the starting order.
- The order of starting for all horses and riders in the second round of each competition will follow the reverse order of the number of penalties in the first round, whether horses are competing for placing or not.

SEA SHOWJUMPING OPEN CHAMPIONSHIPS

THE COURSE

- The courses will be designed by the FEI listed Course Designer (at least of a candidate status) designated by the SEA Showjumping Open Championships Committee.
- The course will be forwarded to the OC 7 days before the announced competitions date.
- The penalties will be calculated according to the FEI Jumping Rules, 21 Edition and rules for.
- Cups might not exceed 22mm in depth. Safety cups are to be used for the back poles of spread fences.
- Electronic timing with display is compulsory and must be recorded in 1/100 of a second.
- The size of the arena (**36x72**) must either be marked out on the ground or railed off.
- The following maximum dimensions apply in three categories. The width of obstacles must not exceed the height by more than 10cm, except for the triple bar:

PRIZES

- Prize money will be awarded only for the first-place winner only in each category (US\$1200/1000/800- Cat. A/B/C).
- The prize money and trophies will be presented during the SEA WC Showjumping Final.
- The winners will be entitled to the complimentary 3 days training package in one of the sponsoring clubs (3Q Equestrian, KL, Malaysia; Arthayasa Stables, Jakarta, Indonesia; Equestrian Paradise, Bangkok, Thailand).
